STANDARD SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS PART ONE

1. **JURISDICTION**

This event is a Clubsport Basic Event, promoted by the Pukekohe Car Club and is being held in a grass paddock in the top field of the Pukekohe Show Grounds on the corner of Birch Road and Youngs Grove.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

3. EVENT DESCRIPTION:

3.1 Pukekohe Car Club – Showgrounds Motorkhana

Motorkhana will be in paddock situated on the corner of Birch Road and Youngs Grove with entry via Gate 11.

- **3.2** Classes: Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:
 - (A) 0 1300cc
 - (B) 1301 1600cc
 - (C) 1601 2000cc
 - (D) 2001 and over
 - (E) 4WD

4. ENTRIES:

4.1 Entries via Motorsport NZ and on the day with a maximum of 50 Competitors.

Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received.

Entries will be accepted on the day of the event, up till 10.30am. There will be no late entry fee incurred.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4.2 Opening and Closing Dates:

Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close at 10.30 am on the day of the event.

5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING:

5.1 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and
- Appendix Five, Schedule C.
- **5.2 Fuel Handling:** Competitors are reminded about the Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel-Storage and Handling. The full details of this Code is found here: http://motorsport.org.nz/resources/safety-training/code-practice-motorsport-fuel
- **5.3** There will be demonstration runs on each course before competition starts.

6. **ELIGIBLE VEHICLES**

- 6.1 All vehicles shall as a minimum be to a warrantable standard, with a securely mounted seat, safe steering and effective brakes.
- **6.2** No Electric/Hybrid vehicles will be permitted.
- **6.3** No Rally Tyres allowed.

7. <u>DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION</u>

- **7.1 Documentation:** Will take place at the venues commencing at 9:30am and concluding at 10:30am
- **7.2 Drivers' Briefing:** This will be held in the paddock pits commencing at 10:30am. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory.

8. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS:

8.1 Pursuant to national Sporting Code Article 13, the organisers reserve the right to postpone or cancel the event.

9. OFFICIAL BULLETINS

9.1 Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

10. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **10.1 Passengers:** May only be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.4.
- 10.2 Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.
- 10.3 Strictly No Dogs Allowed.
- **10.4** Please bring your own food and drinks as we will not be running a BBQ.
- **10.5 Prizegiving:** Will be held as soon as possible after the event.
