# 1. <u>JURISTRICTION</u>

This event is a clusport basic event promoted by the Pukekohe Car Club and will take place on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2025 at 195 Parish Line Road, Ardmore.

The Motorkhana will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules.

This event is open to all members of Motorsport NZ Affiliated Clubs as well as new participants to the sport, provided they have not competed at more than two Club events.

# 3. THE EVENT

# Venue:

Located in a paddock off 195 Parish Line Rd, Ardmore, follow the sign into the driveway, past the house, veer right past the shed then left into the transit paddock. The transit portion in the paddock will be taped off.



# Pits & Event Documentation:

The event pits and documentation tent will be adjacent in the paddock. Follow the thoroughfare track to the pits area.

- Please use a ground sheet when servicing your vehicle
- Pick up all your rubbish
- A toilet will be available

# 5. <u>COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS</u>

Knowledge and Understandings: In signing the entry forms, competitors are deemed to fully understand the Motorsport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. Particularly,

- Appendix Five Schedule C
- All drivers must sign the indemnity & declaration form prior to their participation
- The minimum age of any passenger is 12 years. Passengers under the age of 16 must have a completed "Clubsport Event Underage Indemnity and Consent Form" (MSNZ form CSport002c) or a MSNZ competition license stamped "Authorized Minor". Form CSport002c can be downloaded from the MSNZ website or will be available at the event. This is to be signed by a parent or legal guardian (not just the person taking care of the underage passenger for the day).
- Any competitor who causes damage to Public Property, (e.g. fences) Pukekohe Car Clubs, or their Sponsor's Property will be billed for the damage up to the excess of the Public Liability Insurance policy in the name of Motorsport New Zealand Inc. (Note: current policy excess is \$3,500)
- Any salvaging costs will be at the competitor's expense
- **Fuel Handling:** Competitors are reminded about the Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel-Storage and Handling. # <u>6</u> <u>VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY</u>

Note no WOF required however all vehicles must comply to a WOF standard for the duration of the event.

#### Classes:

Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

(A) 0 - 1300cc



(B) 1301 - 1600cc

(C) 1601 - 2000cc

(D) 2001 and over

(E) 4WD

Organizers reserve the right to combine classes if less than three entries are in a class.

# 7 DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING

Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of licenses and documents and issuing of competition numbers. Documentation will be held at the event document area in the paddock off 195 Parish Line Rd between 8:00am and 9:00am on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2025.

# **8 EVENT PROGRAMME**

- A compulsory Drivers Briefing will be held at 9:00am near documentation. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory
- A Familiarization Run will be held as soon after 9:30am as possible. All competitors must observe the course under the supervision of the Clerk of the Course or nominated official
- Time permitting, all competitors will have two timed runs per course. The organizers reserve the right to reduce the number of runs at their discretion

# 9 TIMING

- Timing is beam start and finish
- Jump starts: Judge of fact (Jumped Start) will be any of the start officials of this event

# 10 PRIZEGIVING/FINAL RESULTS

Provisional results will be posted as soon as possible after the last runs of the final courses. Results will be declared in the final 30 minutes after posting final provisional results.

Results will be posted on the Club Facebook page as soon as possible after the event.

# 11 GENERAL

- <u>NO ANIMALS</u> are allowed at this venue. This is a working farm & we request that you and any supporters respect this. Failure will result in us asking you to leave
- Please ensure any children are well supervised
- All servicing must be done in the designated areas, ground sheets to be used
- Please collect all rubbish at the end of the event in the interest of good Motorsport public relations
- Refunds will be at the organizer's discretion. No refunds will be considered after the start of the reconnaissance run
- Competitor queries should be submitted verbally to the Clerk of Couse
